




















HYPOTHESES

CONCLUSIONS

- The debate about light (and light pollution) is on the rise leading to an increase in conflicts.
- There is a huge variety of (potential) lighting conflicts, making them difficult to grasp.
- A systematic empirical foundation proves difficult however, anecdotal evidence points toward in increase in and a diversity of existing conflicts.
- The debate about lighting, light pollution & the regulation of light will likely develop similarly to that about noise.
